

## Tutorial 2, EC 4020B (Week 4)

**Group 4:** What are the differences of the characteristics of the financial globalization process between developed and developing (and were possible between emerging and least developed) countries between 1945 to the present day?

**Group 5:** “Capital account liberalisation enhances the investment opportunities of developing countries generating higher growth; therefore, they should liberalize the capital account. “ Critically evaluate this statement using theory and empirical evidence. Should an investment-constrained economy be careful in opening its capital account?

**Group 6:** Describe in detail how the trilemma works. For the period 1945 to today, how has the policy mix of industrialised, emerging and developing countries in relation to the trilemma changed over time? Can you say anything about the future of the trilemma for the three groups of countries?
